4.0 Enrollment / Educational Programming

FUTURE ENROLLMENT ASSUMPTIONS

Utilizing the Leicester, MA Historical Enrollment DRAFT report as prepared by NESDEC (New England School Development Council) and dated 8/18/14 as a starting point, and at the direction of the Superintendent of School's office, it was determined that the actual 2013-2014 School Year enrollment of 1,634 students (+-117 students per grade) would form the basis of the future planned enrollment. Anticipating very modest growth over the next 10 years, it was agreed that a grades PK-12 planned enrollment of 1,680 students (120 students/grade) would be utilized for the purposes of the subsequent educational programming and development of preliminary floor plan layout options. A copy of the applicable NESDEC report is included within this *Tab 4*.

EDUCATIONAL PROGRAMMING

Leicester Public Schools currently educates it's children in the following (4) separate school facilities:

- Leicester Primary School grades PK-2
- Leicester Memorial School grades 3-5
- Leicester Middle School grades 6-8
- Leicester High School grades 9-12

During the design team's initial conversations with the elementary school staff (while reviewing the proposed *Project Guiding Principles*), all school participants noted great frustration with the current grades PK-2 and 3-5 educational alignment. The elementary school staff expressed concern regarding the lack of educational continuity (for students, parents, and staff) inherent in elementary age children attending two separate schools for only three years each. As such, it was agreed that all future educational alignment options would include grades PK-5 (7 grades) as a self-contained 'unit'.

Through the multiple meetings/workshops with LPS administrators, teachers, and staff, the design team gathered many ideas regarding potentially different types and kinds of spaces which may be appropriate for future Leicester school facilities. Please refer to the <u>Facilities Capital Committee Meeting #3 Agenda</u> (June 25, 2014), as included within *Tab 3*, for a brief tabulation of some of these ideas.

Preliminary Educational Programs

Following the confirmation of the sizes and number of existing rooms/spaces in the (5) LPS facilities (please refer to *Tabs 5-9* for specific layout and size information), as well as the aforementioned determination of overall planned enrollment, the design team prepared a series of *Preliminary Educational Programs*. Programs were developed for grade PK-5, 6-8, 6-12, 9-12 configurations. Each program includes: relevant assumptions; names & descriptions of spaces; a comparison of sizes (existing, proposed, as well as MSBA guidelines); overall existing LPS spaces available; a comparison to overall MSBA building size planning guidelines for the grade groupings noted; and calculated *educational capacities* of each of the current school facilities. Copies of the final *Preliminary Educational Programs* are included within this *Tab 4*





PK-12 TO 2024 Based On Data Through School Year 2014-15



Leicester, MA Historical & Projected Enrollment


PK-12, 2004-2024
